## Selection Procedure:

- > Selection trials will be organised for **boys only**.
- > Age Criteria:
  - o Cadet: Players born on 1/1/2009 and later
  - o Sub-Junior: Players born on 1/1/2006 and later
  - o Junior: Players born on 1/1/2003 and later
- > PSPB will have the final authority to decide the final total number of players selected for the residential table tennis academy.
- Various parameters will be considered for selection procedure like technical, physical, mental etc. by the selection committee nominated by PSPB.
- > Selected players will participate directly in national ranking tournaments and will represent PSPB Academy.

All players participating in the selection trials should bring their original certificates issued by the School Authorities and Age Proof (strictly as per guidelines of TTFI) without which players will not be allowed to participate in the selection trials.

All the expenses of the selected players for the academy will be borne by PSPB which includes boarding & lodging, T.T training and equipments, education, including school dress & books, fitness training and tournament/matches exposure.
